Day 01: Singapore → Taoyuan

Departure by scheduled flight to Taoyuan International Airport, transferred to your hotel

Day 02: Taipei-Nantou

Jiufen: Once the mountain town abandoned after digging gold fever subsided, the town is bustling again because of the movie "City of Sadness" and becomes as the most popular and longest old street in Taiwan. It provides a wide range of souvenirs and snacks, attracting a large number of tourists. If you come to Jiufen do not miss the famous snack - the taro balls.

Yeliu: The natural rock formations of Yeliu are an amazing array of artistic shapes created by erosion and other natural forces.

Formosan Era Village: is the largest indoor mall with traditions in Asia. The mall consists of old military communities, Hakka villages native tribes, Jiji Train Station the evening market temple yard snack shop...etc. It combines experiences of the traditional lift the eating culture and the reality show faithfully presenting a rich and colorful social landscape.

Day 03: Nantou

Chun Tai Monastery: It is the biggest Buddhist shrine in central Taiwan. The architecture combines both Chinese and Western engineering methods. The temple cost for NT\$4.7 billion can be described as the most advanced five-star temples!

Sun moon Lake: The Sun Moon Lake, located in the middle of Taiwan, with an elevation of 748 meters above sea level, is the only natural big lake in Taiwan. The southern part of Lalu Island is shaped like a new moon, and the northern part is shaped like a sun; hence the name Sun Moon Lake.

Wen-Wu Temple: Located in the northern waist, dedicated to Confucius (Wen-sheng), Yue Fei and Guan Yu (Wu Sheng), named after temples built along the mountain. The temple consisted of three sections, colored golden-yellow, is a typical northern China styled momentum.

Aboriginal Products Shop: Enjoy the aboriginal special show.

Tunnel of Wine Pot: It is composed of hundreds of wine pots and the stacking arrangement is like a tunnel looking from the entrance to the other end.

Day 04: Nantou -Kaohsiung

Cingjing farm: Cingjing farm was established by retired military officers and soldiers. It is stayed up very high altitude, often clouded and foggy, thus named 'Taoyuan in the mist'. A great number of sheep bred in the park and sheep show held on holidays. In the park you may well peak Cilai mountain and beautiful sceneries. It is Taiwan's most beautiful farm.

Pier2Art Zone: Formerly abandoned old warehouse next to the no 2 pier of Kaohsiung it is redesigned to enrich the street with art by organizations related to art combining avant-garde experimental and innovative ideas to build an international platform of kaohsiung City It also allows people more able to get close to art and to feel the because of the city.

Tea Garden: Enjoy the special savor of Taiwan Tea.

Banana Wharf : formerly known as the <banana shed> has been standing in Kaohsiung for nearly half a century and considered one of the most historic buildings in Kaohsiung. During 1950s Taiwan exported bananas massively via this area and now it gradually transited to sightseeing spots related to eating culture. **Takao Cultural Circle:** The small tourist circle is besides Banana Wharf of Kaohsiung. It successfully blended the traditional and new-age style of living.

Jinzuan Night Market: Both of the market are established recently formed side by side and considered the biggest night market in Taiwan if opened simultaneously. It is combined with considerable Taiwanese representative gourmet snacks with cheap price level attracting a considerable number of visitors since the opening.

Day 05: Kaohsiung– Taichung

Pearl Centre: Pearl is a kind of organic precious jewelry. The pearl powder can improve skin.

Fo Guang Shan: Here you will find the Buddhist center of South Taiwan, established by Master Hsing Yun and his disciples. The architecture of the temples is very characteristic, and at the southeastern side of Fo Guang Mountain (Gunag Shan) Monastery the most prominent landmark of the region is found: a huge golden statue of Buddha Amitaabha which measures some 120 meters.

Meinong Hakka Village: Meinong Hakka Cultural Museum is located as a local landmark. It has the important mission of the preservation of Hakka culture and heritage. Thrifty hard Hakka traditional virtues and spirit is revealed.

Moon World: It is famous for its barren terrain landscape. The place, surrounded by schungite clay and rocks, looks like the terrain of Moon thus called the Moon World.

Feng Jia Night Market: Exhibit fashion aura, local snacks, enjoy the shopping and bargain.

Day 06: Taichung –Taipei

Yang Ming Shan National Park: It is close to the Taipei metropolitan area therefore is so-called Back Garden of Taipei and is an famous summer resort in northern Taiwan. Big Flower Clock is a place you have to visit and take pictures in the park.

Xiao Youkeng: Yangmingshan is a sleeping volcanic zone and Xiao Youkeng is its largest crater. It is located in peak of Yangmingshan, erupting sulfur gases all the years thus became Taiwan's special geological landscape.

Taipei 101 Shopping Mall (observatory fee own expenses): Taipei 101 with height of 508 meters is a new landmark in Taipei. This building is an integration of the classical Oriental culture and Taiwan local characteristics offering elegant and spacious shopping space within the shopping center.

Shihlin Night Market: It is one of the most popular night markets in Taipei City, known for its traditional snacks such as chicken steak, smelly tofu, oyster dumplings, frog eggs and Shihlin sausages and more. Shihlin Night Market is not only good for food but also a good choice of shopping.

Pixiou Arts Center: It's a pair of mythical animals. People believe that Pixiou can help them to earn money and bring lucky also.

Cake Shop: Monopoly famous pastry worth to taste.

Day 07: Taipei – Singapore
