Day 01: Singapore → Taoyuan

Departure by scheduled flight to Taoyuan International Airport, transferred to your hotel

Day 02: Taipei - Hualien

Jiufen: Once the mountain town abandoned after digging gold fever subsided, the town is bustling again because of the movie "City of Sadness" and becomes as the most popular and longest old street in Taiwan. It provides a wide range of souvenirs and snacks, attracting a large number of tourists. If you come to Jiufen do not miss the famous snack - the taro balls.

Hsueshan Tunnel: Hsueshan Tunnel with length of 12.9 km is the longest highway tunnel in Taiwan, the second longest road tunnel in Asia, and ranked fifth in the world. The tunnel goes through the snow-capped mountains so named " Hsueshan Tunnel".

Coral Matsu: It is a well-known temple in Ilan. The Matsu statue was carved with precious deep-sea gems coral and it is also the largest coral Matsu in Taiwan.

Qingshui Cliff: Is one of the most spectacular sights on Taiwan's Pacific coast. The cliff is more than 1,000 meters high and drops almost vertically into the sea. The highway snakes along its curving face more than 20 kilometers, with the sheer cliff rising on one side and a sheer drop to the ocean on the other.

Taroko National Park: Taroko is famous for its spectacular mountains and marble canyons. Cliffs and canyons stretch along Liwu River. Four million years ago, the island of Taiwan was formed by the collision of plates. After millions of years of wind erosion, the marble rocks were exposed and cut by Liwu River, creating impressive grand canyons.

Swallow Grotto: This part of Tailuge (Taroko) Gorge is composed of marble cliff faces covered with small holes, the result of long-term erosion by river and ground water. House swifts and Pacific swallows often forage and nest here, giving the place its name.

Eternal Spring Shrine: Spring water adjacent by the Eternal Spring Shine (Changchun Temple)flows all year round and the Highway Bureau named it after "Changchun Falls" It is now scenic spot with special significance on the Central Cross-Island Highway.

Day 03: Hualien - Taitung

Chihsing Tan Scenic Area: The beach there has an elegant arch shape. The seawater there is clean and blue. The black stones there are crystal. From here visitors can see the great green mountains afar and the twisting highways.

Taiyuan Glen: Taiyuan Glen situated in Taitung County runs directly through the Huang Tung coastal mountain range. The valley is surrounded by a chain of mountains. The magnificent of the steep-walled cliffs and broken ridges on both sides forms an imposing manner.

Water Goes Up: Here you may witness a strange scenery that water really flows upwards.

Day 04: Taitung -Kaohsiung

Buddha Memorial Center: Built to worship buddha's relic, the construction combines both Chinese and foreign techniques and skills. The main statue of the temple is 108 meters high and considered as the tallest statue of the world.

Pearl Centre: Pearl is a kind of organic precious jewelry. The pearl powder can improve skin.

The Chijin Street: Chijin, also named Chiho, is an elongated island so ferry is the major transportation. Tin Hau Temple with three hundred years of history is a third class monument. The island's seafood quite delicious and often attract large numbers of tourists to visit.

Love River Cruises: The riverbanks were beautified with greenery works and developed to be park areas, decorated with pillars chained with iron rope. The area becomes a romantic place for lovers to date with each other, therefore, the river was reputed as Love River.

Leo He Night Market: Special Taiwances snacks .Experience for Taiwances food culture.

Day 05: Kaohsiung– Taichung

Moon World: It is famous for its barren terrain landscape. The place, surrounded by schungite clay and rocks, looks like the terrain of Moon thus called the Moon World.

Sun moon Lake: The Sun Moon Lake, located in the middle of Taiwan, with an elevation of 748 meters above sea level, is the only natural big lake in Taiwan. The southern part of Lalu Island is shaped like a new moon, and the northern part is shaped like a sun; hence the name Sun Moon Lake.

Wen-Wu Temple: Located in the northern waist, dedicated to Confucius (Wen-sheng), Yue Fei and Guan Yu (Wu Sheng), named after temples built along the mountain. The temple consisted of three sections, colored golden-yellow, is a typical northern China styled momentum with magnificent and unique appearance.

Aboriginal Products Shop: Enjoy the aboriginal special show.

Tea Garden: Enjoy the special savor of Taiwan Tea.

Feng Jia Night Market: Exhibit fashion aura, local snakes , enjoy the shopping and bargain.

Day 06: Taichung –Taipei

The Grand Hotel: Taiwan's first five-star hotel with the appearance of ancient Chinese palace. It is where Taiwan government held a state banquet and to serve leaders from other countries. It is also an important tourist landmark in Taipei.

Taipei 101 Shopping Mall (observatory fee own expenses): Taipei 101 with height of 508 meters is a new landmark in Taipei. This building is an integration of the classical Oriental culture and Taiwan local characteristics offering elegant and spacious shopping space within the shopping center.

Shihlin Night Market: It is one of the most popular night markets in Taipei City, known for its traditional snacks such as chicken steak, smelly tofu, oyster dumplings, frog eggs and Shihlin sausages and more, Shihlin Night Market is not only good for food but also a good choice of shopping.

Pixiou Arts Center: It's a pair of mythical animals. People believe that Pixiou can help them to earn money and bring lucky also.

Cake Shop: Monopoly famous pastry worth to taste.

Day 07: Taipei → Singapore
