### Day 01: Singapore → Taoyuan

Departure by scheduled flight to Taoyuan International Airport, transferred to your hotel

### Day 02: Taipei -Yilan

**Jingtong Station:** The Jingtong Train Station is a very old wooden station. The station still keeps old railway equipment such as desks, coal cabinets, signal lights and old-fashioned telephones from Japanese occupation.

**Shifen Old Street:** Shifen Old Street is located along the the Pingxi largest train station and railways. It is not only well-known to the old buildings, but also to the unique view that trains pass by in closed distance. The trains often bring surprises to tourists. The streets are lined with considerable number of sky lanterns and souvenir shops.

**Jiufen:** Once the mountain town abandoned after digging gold fever subsided, the town is bustling again because of the movie "City of Sadness" and becomes as the most popular and longest old street in Taiwan. It provides a wide range of souvenirs and snacks, attracting a large number of tourists. If you come to Jiufen do not miss the famous snack - the taro balls.

**Gold Museum:** It is a retention and excavation of culture and heritage of the gold mining process during Japanese occupation. The museum still keeps the biggest gold brick in Taiwan. The Japanese style of architecture is also worth for a visit.

**Yinyang Sea:** Due to the Jingua mountain area streams flowed into the sea, high mineral content soaked in the water, so the sea coast formed half golden half blue wonders. This landscape was called "Yin-Yang Sea".

**Beiguan Tide Park:** The tide of Beiguan is very spectacular. Ilan mountains formed in Beiguan a pass. From the sea platform you can overlook Turtle Island and the Lanyang Plain.

**Crab Museum:** It is the world's first crab themed museum . It exhibits a wide variety of collections of crab specimens.

### Day 03: Yilan – Hsinchu - Taichung

**Jimmy Theme park:** Located next to the train station of Jimmy's hometown. It designed to create a park according to the scenes of his book,such as "Turn Left, Turn Right" and "Star",illustrating the story and the characters in front of you.

**Lefoo Vilge Theme Park:** In the theme park are the Arabian Palace, American Western Streets, South Pacific Ocean and Wild Life Kingdom, where tourists can have a good time. Besides scheduled performances, there are also amusement facilities and food and drink services. People can experience thrilling and also exciting entertainments here. It is full of laughers.

**Feng Jia Night Market:** Exhibit fashion aura,local snakes ,enjoy the shopping and bargain.

### Day 04: Taichung - Nantou

**Formosan Era Village:** Formosan Era Village is the largest indoor mall with traditions in Asia. The consists of old military communities, Hakka village native tribes Jiji Train Station the evening market temple yard snack shop...etc. It combines experiences of the traditional life, the eating culture and the reality show faithfully presenting a rich and colorful social landscape.

**Sun moon Lake:** The Sun Moon Lake, located in the middle of Taiwan, with an elevation of 748 meters above sea level, is the only natural big lake in Taiwan. The southern part of Lalu Island is shaped like a new moon, and the northern part is shaped like a sun; hence the name Sun Moon Lake.

**Wen-Wu Temple:** Located in the northern waist, dedicated to Confucius (Wen-sheng), Yue Fei and Guan Yu (Wu Sheng), named after temples built along the mountain. The temple consisted of three sections, colored golden-yellow, is a typical northern China styled momentum. with magnificent and unique appearance.

**Peacock Garden:** Peacock Park was founded in 1968. It is a mini zoo located by the ring road of Sun Moon Lake. In order to beautify of the Sun Moon Lake, late president Chiang Kai-shek asked General He Ying-qin and Provincial Minister Huang Jie and so on to build this park for tourists visiting for free.

**Aboriginal Products Shop:** Enjoy the aboriginal special show.

### Day 05: Nantou - Hsinchu

**Pearl Centre:** Pearl is a kind of organic precious jewelry. The pearl powder can improve skin.

**Moncoeur Manor:** Is a lavender-themed forest park co-designed by the famous writer Mili presenting a unique style of garden landscaping and a romantic manor with love (An NT200 voucher supports the service of coffee and dessert).

**Tahu Strawberry Winer :** The Tahu Winery is located in the hometown of strawberries of Taiwan, and is the first domestic winery that produce strawberry wines. And it is also the only strawberry winery in Asia. You can witness the process of making strawberry wine and the ecology of strawberry farms.

**Beipu Hakka Village:** Beipu combined two different cultures Hakka and Minnan. Years ago Minnan culture faded away from the villiage and Hakka became the major culture. The village not only provides a considerable number of Hakka cuisine but also many thing related to Hakka heritage.

**Glass Crafts Museum:** The museum exhibits glass crafts of local art creators ih Hsinchu . There are many activities and exhibitions related to glass crafts held in the museum from time to time.

**Hsinchu City God Temple:** It is Taiwan's largest City God Temple. The temple dedicated to Wellin God, ranked the supreme deity of all City God Temples in Taiwan. Hsinchu tourists often visit the holy land, in which there are a considerable number of renowned Hsinchu snacks such as pork ball soup, rice noodle, oyster omelets, Rouzao rice, four God soup ... await for you to taste.

### Day 06: Hsinchui –Taipei

**Shilin Residence:** It is the residence of President Chiang Kai-shek during his lifetime. Here you can feel the style of life of President. It is reconstructed to an ecological park. From time to time it holds flower shows for visitors to enjoy.

**Wufenpu :** There are nearly one thousand of the garment shops in this gathering, which sourced from across the province and other places such as Hong Kong, Thailand and South Korea. The clothes with high quality sold in wholesale price here so attracted many young people come to shopping.

**Taipei 101 Shopping Mall (observatory fee own expenses):** Taipei 101 with height of 508 meters is a new landmark in Taipei. This building is an integration of the classical Oriental culture and Taiwan local characteristics offering elegant and spacious shopping space within the shopping center.

**Pixiou Arts Center:** It's a pair of mythical animals.People believe that Pixiou can help them to earn money and bring lucky also.

**Cake Shop:** Monopoly famous pastry worth to taste.

**Raohe Street Tourist Night Market:** It is 600 meters in length, near Shongshan Railway Station. There is a decorated-archway in front of the entrance. There are various shops and stands in the night market. It presents Taiwanese characteristic and is definitely a place worth visiting.
