Day 01: Singapore → Taoyuan

Departure by scheduled flight to Taoyuan International Airport, transferred to your hotel.

Day 02: Taipei-Taichung

Jiufen: Once the mountain town abandoned after digging gold fever subsided, the town is bustling again because of the movie "City of Sadness" and becomes as the most popular and longest old street in Taiwan. It provides a wide range of souvenirs and snacks, attracting a large number of tourists. If you come to Jiufen do not miss the famous snack - the taro balls.

Yong Heng Wen Creative park: It is a private Park with one hundred thousand windmills to create a special Landscapes praying for luck and happiness.

Shin sheh Castle: has been the biggest secret garden in Taichung. Walking into the garden, it is like being in medieval European castle. It retains the original forest blended together with the new development of many artificial landscaping providing a romantic European environment to be experienced like a secluded paradise.

Feng Jia Night Market: Exhibit fashion aura, local snakes ,enjoy the shopping and bargain.

Day 03: Taichung - Kaohsiung

Rainbow Village: It was originally a military community planned to be demolished . A resident tried to keep it and turned the cold and turned the cold and abandoned community into a vivid landscape of painting.Finally the governmentdecided to keep the innovation and canceled the demolishing .

Salt Museum: A salt themed Japanese style cultural center provides experiences of the most representative 366 days birthday color salt.

Great Queen of Heaven Temple: Datianhou Temple (Taina Grand Matsu Temple) is commonly known as a Mazu Temple of Tainan- the first Mazu Temple built by the government in Taiwan. The god worshipped in Datianhou Temple (Taina Grand Matsu Temple) is The Heaven God Mother, or widely called Mother Mazu, the most worshipped god in the Taiwanese society. It was the master piece of a sculptor from Chuan Chou about 300 years ago and is the representative work of Taiwan's sculpturing of its kind.

Anping Old Stree :The oldest streets in Taiwan thus also known as 'Taiwan's First Streets are lined with many special shop such as grocery stores traditional toy stores snack bars and many othet Tainanlocal snacks.

Dream Mall (Ferris Whee own expense): Dream Mall was built by the Uni-President Group. It is cost \$ 30 billion dollars and has become Taiwan's largest shopping center. Its shape looks exactly like a whale, quite a distinctive view, with a Hello Kitty Ferris wheel on the top.

Formosa Versailles: The museum sponsored by Chimei Corporation is located within the Metropolitan park in Tainan and has become the latest attraction in Southern Taiwan .It was built as European style with Western art and culture.

Jinzuan Night Market: Both of the market are established recently formed side by side and considered the biggest night market in Taiwan if opened simultaneously. It is combined with considerable Taiwanese representative gourmet snacks with cheap price level attracting a considerable number of visitors since the opening.

Day 04: Kaohsiung - Tainan

Buddha Memorial: Built to worship buddha's relic the construction combines both Chinese and foreign techiques and skills. The main statue of the temple is 108 meters high and considered as the tallest statue of the world .

Pearl Centre: Pearl is a kind of organic precious jewelry, The pearl powder can improve skin.

Meinong Hakka Village: Meinong Hakka Cultural Museum is located as a local landmark. It has the important mission of the preservation of Hakka culture and heritage. Thrifty hard Hakka traditional virtues and spirit is revealed.

Tseng Wen Reservoir Scaling Ladder:Is located within the Siraya National Park for the purpose of improvement and expansion of the southern area of farmland irrigation.It also provides diversified functions of power generation flood control and tourism. It is Taiwan's largest reservoir with a beautiful environment of lakes and mountains .These scenes are under your exploration from the top of the ladder.

Day 05: Tainan – Nantou

Sun moon Lake: The Sun Moon Lake, located in the middle of Taiwan, with an elevation of 748 meters above sea level, is the only natural big lake in Taiwan. The southern part of Lalu Island is shaped like a new moon, and the northern part is shaped like a sun; hence the name Sun Moon Lake.

Wen-Wu Temple: Located in the northern waist, dedicated to Confucius (Wen-sheng), Yue Fei and Guan Yu (Wu Sheng), named after temples built along the mountain. The temple consisted of three sections, colored golden-yellow, is a typical northern China styled momentum.with magnificent and unique appearance.

Aboriginal Products Shop: Enjoy the aboriginal special show.

Tunnel of Wine Pot: It is composed of hundreds of wine pots and the stacking arrangement is like a tunnel looking from the entrance to the other end.

Tea Garden: Enjoy the special savor of Taiwan Tea.

Formosan Era Village: Is the largest indoor mall with traditions in Asia. The mall consists of old military communities,Hakka vilages native tribes, Jiji Train Station the evening market temple yard snack shop...etc. It combines experiences of the traditional lift the eating culture and the reality show faithfully presenting a rich and colorful social landscape.

Day 06: Nantou –Taipei

EsLite Creative Living Bookshop: The most popular shopping center combined with functions of bookstores and creative boutiques. It carries diversifications of books considered the biggest bookshop in Taiwan.

Longshan Temple: It is a 2nd degree national monument with the characteristics of Taiwan's traditional temples. It is also one of the most popular temples in Taiwan.

Taipei 101 Shopping Mall (observatory fee own expenses): Taipei 101 with height of 508 meters is a new landmark in Taipei. This building is an integration of the classical Oriental culture and Taiwan local characteristics offering elegant and spacious shopping space within the shopping center.

Mongga Huaxi Street: Huaxi Street Night Market is based on food and snacks, ranging from seafood to snake soup. Here you can enjoy a variety of snacks and you can feel the style of the early life in Taiwan.

Pixiou Arts Center: It's a pair of mythical animals.People believe that Pixiou can help them to earn money and bring lucky also.

Cake Shop: Monopoly famous pastry worth to tast
