### Day 01: Singapore → Taoyuan

Departure by scheduled flight to Taoyuan International Airport, transferred to your hotel

### Day 02: Taipei-Hualien

**Jiufen:** Once the mountain town abandoned after digging gold fever subsided, the town is bustling again because of the movie "City of Sadness" and becomes as the most popular and longest old street in Taiwan. It provides a wide range of souvenirs and snacks, attracting a large number of tourists. If you come to Jiufen do not miss the famous snack - the taro balls.

**Taroko National Park:** Taroko is famous for its spectacular mountains and marble canyons. Cliffs and canyons stretch along Liwu River. Four million years ago, the island of Taiwan was formed by the collision of plates. After millions of years of wind erosion, the marble rocks were exposed and cut by Liwu River, creating impressive grand canyons.

**Swallow Grotto:** This part of Tailuge (Taroko) Gorge is composed of marble cliff faces covered with small holes, the result of long-term erosion by river and ground water. House swifts and Pacific swallows often forage and nest here, giving the place its name.

**Eternal Spring Shrine:** Spring water adjacent by the Eternal Spring Shrine (Changchun Temple) flows all year round and the Highway Bureau named it after "Changchun Falls" It is now scenic spot with special significance on the Central Cross-Island Highway.

### Day 03: Hualien - Taitung

**Chihshing Tan Scenic Area:** The beach there has an elegant arch shape. The seawater there is clean and blue. The black stones there are crystal. From here visitors can see the great green mountains afar and the twisting highways.

**Li You Tan:** It is the biggest inland lake in Hualien. You may experience boating here and also witness the greatness of mother nature.

**Rei Suei Ranch:** This ranch is located besides Red Leaves Creek with very beautiful scenery, clean water, fresh air, rich grasslands, and with potential for development of animal husbandry. The visitors can enjoy fresh milk and milk bread.

**Luye Highlands:** The highlands of Luye Township is a famous Yosemite in East Rift. The high-condescending view is very good. You can see the distant mountains, broad Peinan River, East Rift Valley, as well as Longtian farmland.

### Day 04: Taitung -Kaohsiung

**Kenting National Park:** Dazzling bright sunshine, azure blue seawater, clean shining sand beach..., This is Taiwan's first national park-Kenting, renowned for its rich landscape of hills and water, abundant life, and natural resources for everyone's enjoyment.

**National Museum of Marine Biology & Aquarium:** It occupies the total area 96.81 hectares, mainly presenting the characteristics of "water". The museum consists of three theme exhibitions including Taiwan Waters, Coral Kingdom and World Waters. The Coral Kingdom Pavilion has an 84 meters underwater tunnel built in 1.5 million gallons of man-made ocean let visitors experience the gorgeous of coral world.

**Buddha Memorial Center:** Built to worship buddha's relic, the construction combines both Chinese and foreign techniques and skills. The main statue of the temple is 108 meters high and considered as the tallest statue of the world.

**Xinjujiang Night Market:** Young people, new fashion, recreation, shopping and dining all collide at New Juejiang, which is rapidly sucking in new businesses to become Kaohsiung's biggest shopping destination. New Juejiang is the place to go in southern Taiwan for imported goods and chic attire, much of it arriving in step with debuts in the fashion capitals of the world.

**Love River Cruises:** The riverbanks were beautified with greenery works and developed to be park areas, decorated with pillars chained with iron rope. The area becomes a romantic place for lovers to date with each other, therefore, the river was reputed as Love River.

### Day 05: Kaohsiung- Chiayi

**Pearl Centre:** Pearl is a kind of organic precious jewelry. The pearl powder can improve skin.

**Alishan Forest Park:** Alishan is very famous for the sunrise view and the cloud ocean. The clouds are so dense and thick that the mountaintops appear like islands on the cloud ocean. The best time to watch the cloud season is autumn and visitors can go to Ziyun Temple, Alishan Hotel, Alishan Rail Station, Zaoping Park and the first parking lot.

### Day 06: Chiayi - Taichung

**Sun moon Lake:** The Sun Moon Lake, located in the middle of Taiwan, with an elevation of 748 meters above sea level, is the only natural big lake in Taiwan. The southern part of Lalu Island is shaped like a new moon, and the northern part is shaped like a sun; hence the name Sun Moon Lake.

**Wen-Wu Temple:** Located in the northern waist, dedicated to Confucius (Wen-sheng), Yue Fei and Guan Yu (Wu Sheng), named after temples built along the mountain. The temple consisted of three sections, colored golden-yellow, is a typical northern China styled mentum. with magnificent and unique appearance.

**Aboriginal Products Shop:** Enjoy the aboriginal special show.

**Tea Garden:** Enjoy the special savor of Taiwan Tea.

**Feng Jia Night Market:** Exhibit fashion aura, local snakes, enjoy the shopping and bargain.

### Day 07: Taichung -Taipei

**CKS Memorial Hall:** Chiang Kai-shek Memorial Hall was built to commemorate the late President Chiang Kai-shek. It is a popular resort which activities, gatherings and wedding photography seen all the time and it is a place that foreign tourists have to visit.

**Ximending:** Here is a collection of all the favorite of the young people nowadays including movies, fashion, popular collectables, tattoos, international cuisine, idol singer autograph ... Ximending becomes teenagers new paradise.

**Taipei 101 Shopping Mall (observatory fee own expenses):** Taipei 101 with height of 508 meters is a new landmark in Taipei. This building is an integration of the classical Oriental culture and Taiwan local characteristics offering elegant and spacious shopping space within the shopping center.

**Shihlin Night Market:** It is one of the most popular night markets in Taipei City, known for its traditional snacks such as chicken steak, smelly tofu, oyster dumplings, frog eggs and Shihlin sausages and more. Shihlin Night Market is not only good for food but also a good choice of shopping.

**Pixiou Arts Center:** It's a pair of mythical animals. People believe that Pixiou can help them to earn money and bring lucky also.

**Cake Shop:** Monopoly famous pastry worth to taste.
